SIGN AT THE END OF STOKE MILL LANE

Cllr Frampton has reported that there is a sign but it is not very prominent. He will look into it further and report at the next meeting to stop ordinary vehicles travelling down the lane and thinking that it is a normal road.

CARS BEING GROUNDED ON COLLAPSED ROADSIDE EDGE ON CUTTY STUBBS HILL

Cllr Frampton has twice had to pull out cars on the hill on Bluntshay Lane, because it is not at all obvious that the road edges are totally collapsed, and can harm the undersides of cars.

CHURCH PATH NEAR WAKELYS FARM, WHITCHURCH

Several parishioners have complained that it is dangerous walking down this path to the church, because, besides the very rough surface under foot, both sides of the hedge above the path need trimming back. I have been in touch with the owners on both sides of the path, and one has asked Stephen Lee to deal with it asap, and the other one has said that they would want to wait until the birds have finished nesting before they trim anything. The owner on the left hand side has said that some bushes/small trees have been left on the hedge opposite their door which is blocking out the light on their property. The owner on the other side of the path is to investigate this and relay the problem to the lengthsman.
