

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BERNE LANE, CHARMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along BERNE LANE, CHARMOUTH between the entrance to Burnside and the entrance to Bafferlands Farm, a distance of approximately 455 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 0800 and 1700 on 08 July 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 09 July 2024.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to replace pole.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Tizard's Knap - A35
